



Conditions of Entry

- All work submitted must be original.
- Entries will be accepted from individuals, groups (no more than 3 students) and whole classes.
- Entries will be judged by categories and stage and prizes awarded to individual students, groups (of no more than 3) and classes.
- Judging will be by a panel including an author and an artist.
- A maximum of two entries per student allowed (can be in each category or same category).
- An entry form for hard copy entries is available on the website. Entries in other formats should include student first name and last name initial, age, school and class.
- Entries in the writing category can be up to 500 words.
- Individual entries restricted to A4 size. Posters welcome for group/class entries.
- Entries must be received by 29th March 2021.
- Schools can submit entries digitally to bitterns@wetlands.org.au or in hard copy or USB. These can be posted PO Box 66 Shortland 2307 or delivered to the Visitor Centre at Hunter Wetlands Centre 1 Wetlands Place, Shortland (open 9am to 4pm daily) or in some circumstances arrangements to pick them up may be possible.
- Winners will be announced on the HWCA website and schools will be notified by email.
- A selection of entries will be displayed at the Hunter Wetlands Centre during the April school holidays.
- Important dates:
 - Entries open: 1st February 2021.
 - Register for author presentation by 8th February 2021.
 - Register for information session by 8th February 2021.
 - Entries close: 29th March 2021.
 - Winners announced: 31st March 2021.
 - Entries displayed at HWCA from 1st April 2021 to 19th April 2021.
