



## OOSH Group Conditions of Entry

- All work submitted must be original.
- Entries will be accepted from individuals or groups.
- Entries will be judged by categories and prizes awarded to individual students and groups.
- Judging will be by a panel including an author and an artist.
- A maximum of two entries per student allowed (can be in each category or same category).
- An entry form for hard copy entries is available on the website. Entries in other formats should include student first name and last name initial, age, and OOSH Group name and contact number.
- Entries in the writing category can be up to 500 words.
- Individual entries restricted to A4 size. Posters welcome for group entries.
- Entries must be received by 26<sup>th</sup> March 2021.
- OOSH Group can submit entries digitally to [bitterns@wetlands.org.au](mailto:bitterns@wetlands.org.au) or in hard copy or USB. These can be posted PO Box 66 Shortland 2307 or delivered to the Visitor Centre at Hunter Wetlands Centre 1 Wetlands Place, Shortland (open 9am to 4pm daily) or in some circumstances arrangements to pick them up may be possible.
- Winners will be announced on the HWCA website and groups will be notified by email.
- A selection of entries will be displayed at the Hunter Wetlands Centre during the April school holidays.
- Important dates:

Entries close: 26<sup>th</sup> March 2021.  
Winners announced: 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021.  
Entries displayed at HWCA from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021 to 19<sup>th</sup> April 2021.
