Breeding Swans, Purple Swamphen and Dusky Moorhen. Also a few fledged Great and Cattle Egrets still left on Melaleuca/Middletons Swamps. Of interest we saw no Magpie Geese or Coots – must have spread out with all the rain. PLVal 47 species and 699 birds (not counted the Bell Miner colony)
